BOARD

- Next executive board meeting April 9, 2021 (10:00am)
- Next general board meeting May 29, 2021 (10:00am)
- The board sent a letter of gratitude to the provincial government regarding our recent move to phase 2 and the reduction in quarantine time for materials. The letter is on page three of this report.
- The Executive passed a motion on Friday evening to extend the salary budget to accommodate two
 new staff positions in our technology services area. Our organizational restructure is taking shape –
 stay tuned.

OPERATIONS

- We welcomed back Rhonda Cusack on Monday the 15th. Rhonda is taking on a new role as Member Library Services Clerk. This position will allow our consulting librarians greater time to focus on the needs of our libraries.
- The TRAC directors met this week. Our Polaris system is set for a big upgrade on Monday, April 19th.
 This will require a system outage on that day as the index is rebuilt. Library managers will soon receive a document outlining the changes and enhancements with this upgrade.

Dear Ministers,

The Northern Lights Library System would like to thank you for your tireless efforts on behalf of all Albertans in our fight against the COVID-19 pandemic. Thank you for your service, and your swift and thoughtful actions to protect Albertans, the economy, and our most vulnerable populations.

The general board of the Northern Lights Library System met February 26th and resolved to send a letter of support for the many letters you undoubtedly received from libraries throughout the province. These letters asked the government to reconsider the classification of libraries within the current path forward framework to move libraries to stage 2. Though we worked swiftly to draft that letter it was announced by the end of February that libraries would move to stage 2. We were delighted that the province heard and responded to the concerns of libraries across the province. We are grateful for your responsiveness and your willingness to listen.

In early March a town hall meeting was held and concerns were delivered regardding the mandatory 72 hour quarantine of materials. Again, our concerns were heard, and available data and scientific literature was consulted on the need for quarantining library materials. Subsequently, that quarantine period was reduced from 72 to 24 hours.

These are difficult times, with immense pressures on our public servants. We thank you for listening and for acting in the best interest of Albertans.
