"We have invited all children to come to the library to help us make an "Orange Shirt Garland" and we will decorate the Tipi with that garland to honor the Indigenous children who endured residential schools in Canada."

"Staff will be wearing our Orange shirts. We have a story walk planned for the week through the weekend. The story will be Our Orange Hearts"

"In addition to the activity of September 30th we will have to Workshops at the Library where a local Indigenous artist will be teaching how to make Beaded Jewelry in a 2-day workshop (October 1st. and Oct. 8th)"
