These committee members have planned some great activities for NLLS libraries and their patrons to participate in. NLLS hosted an in-person programming day on April 24th with a focus on this year's program. One popular program repeating this year is the Summer Pen Pal. - Voted to recommend that for 2023, NLLS use the population numbers that were used in the budget that was approved in November 2022. (Option #1)
- Voted to recommend that NLLS continues to use the same population figures as PLSB for the levy. The managers expressed that the most important was consistence and advance notice.
- Voted to evenly divide the 2023 surplus funds in the budget amongst the member libraries so that they could use the money as they saw fit. Some examples of use were to add the money to the book allotment, purchase program materials and replace aging computers.
